What are the changes?

From 1st January 2017, all seafarers are required to demonstrate that they have maintained the competence levels required to safely carry out tasks, duties and responsibilities regarding emergency, occupational safety and survival functions.

What does this mean?

All personnel serving on board ship and qualified in any of the following must as of the 1 January 2017 have documentary evidence of either completing the training course or updating training within the last 5 years;

- Personal Survival Techniques
- Fire Prevention & Fire Fighting
- Advanced Fire Fighting
- Survival Craft and Rescue Boats
- Fast Rescue Boats

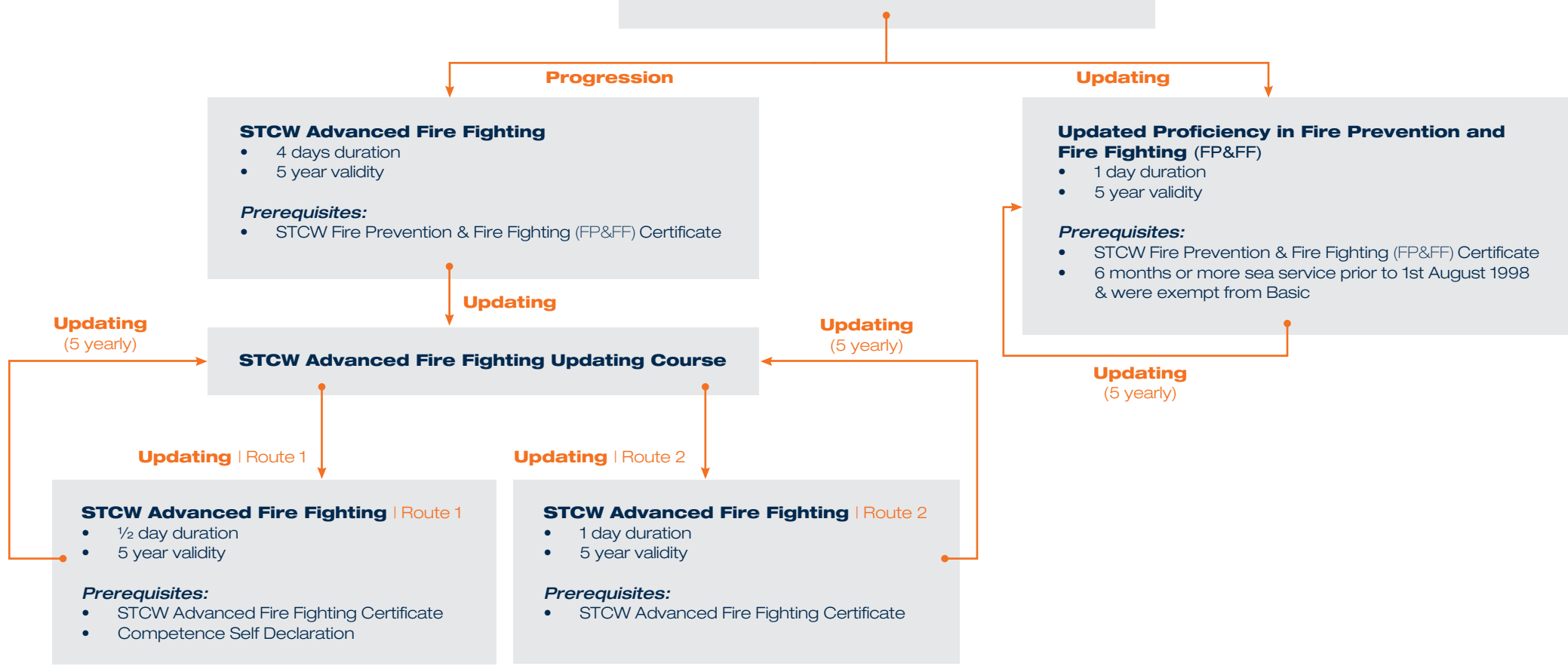

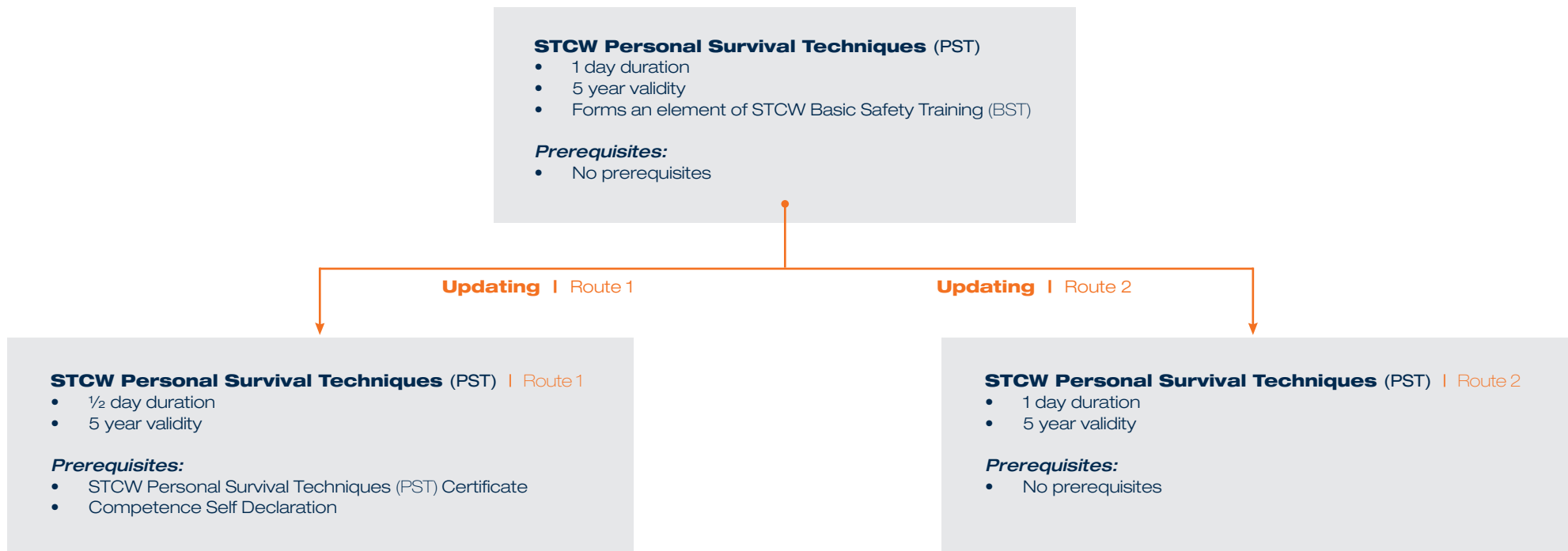

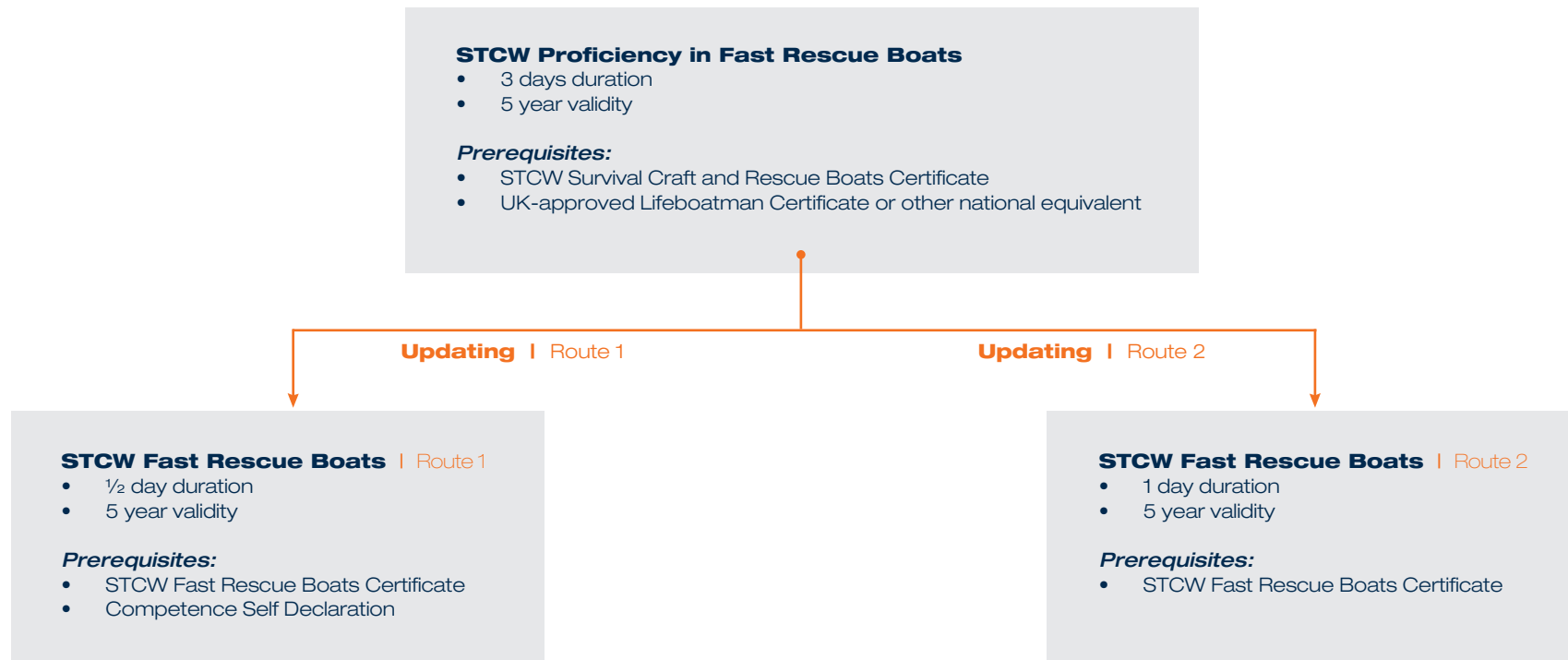
