Offshore Survival Training

The information contained in this Helpsheet is meant to serve as a guide only. Operators and employers may have additional requirements based on job role and / or location, as well as company specific processes and procedures to consider.

Step 1: Choosing the Right Course for You...

The certification you require will largely be dictated by the location you intend to travel to for work. Select from the below options as appropriate;

Option 1: Combined BOSIET (OPITO ref: 5750 & 5700)

OPITO Combined Basic Offshore Safety Induction & Emergency Training (BOSIET) with HUET, CA-EBS & EBS (3 days)

A Combined BOSIET will provide training in the use of both the Category A Emergency Breathing System and Emergency Breathing Systems.

We recommend this option to those who may be required to work within both UK, Danish *and* International waters – or for those who are unsure of where they may be based in the future.

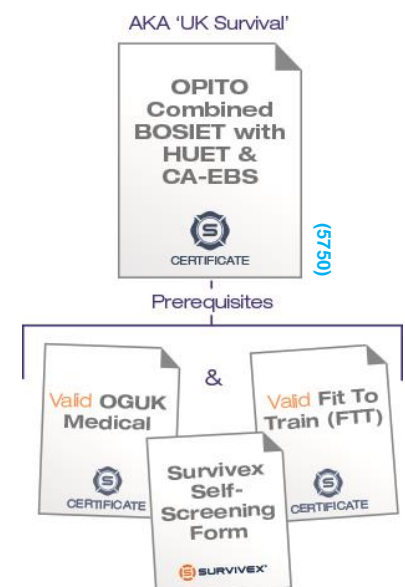
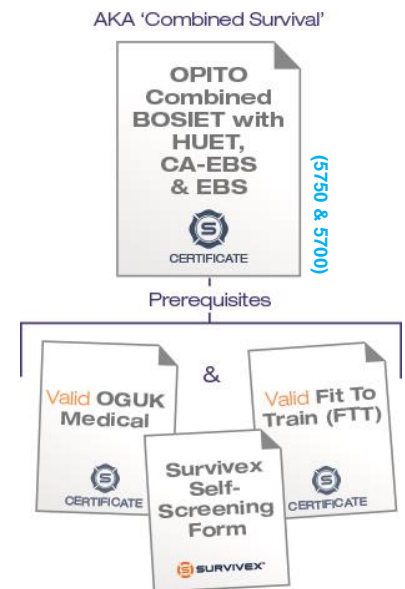
Prerequisites: Delegates are required to hold a valid **OGUK Medical** *and* **Fit To Train Assessment** prior to completing the in-water exercises. You will also be required to complete a medical self-screening form prior to course commencement.

Option 2: BOSIET with CA-EBS only (OPITO ref: 5750)

OPITO Combined Basic Offshore Safety Induction & Emergency Training (BOSIET) with HUET and CA-EBS (3 days)

This option covers you for regions that operate using the Compressed Air Emergency Breathing System (CA-EBS) - this system is now utilised in the UKCS and will be utilised in Danish waters from 1st October 2018. (Please note that if this option is selected there is no “upgrade” available to complete EBS training at a later date).

Prerequisites: As above.

Option 3: BOSIET with EBS only (OPITO ref: 5700)

OPITO Combined Basic Offshore Safety Induction & Emergency Training (BOSIET) with HUET and EBS (3 days)

This covers you for regions that operate using the Emergency Breathing System (EBS). This is mainly utilised internationally and is *not* suitable for people expecting to work in UK waters. This will not be suitable for people expecting to work in Danish waters from 1st October 2018 unless additional CA-EBS training (OPITO ref. 5902) has been completed.

Prerequisites: Delegates will be required to complete a medical self-screening form prior to course commencement.

Refresher: Combined, CA-EBS or EBS (OPITO ref: 5850 & 5858)

Further Offshore Emergency Training (FOET) (1 day)

As with the BOSIET, you will be required to select Option 1, 2 or 3.

Note: Refresher training must be undertaken **BEFORE** certificate expiry.

Prerequisites: A valid BOSIET or FOET Certificate. Additional requirements as per relevant Survival option (1, 2 or 3).

Step 2: Choosing Add-ons...

These additional elements can be added to your chosen Survival package;

Add-on 1: OGUK Medical

Included within duration of course (approx 60 mins if completed separately)

This certification is a prerequisite for anyone travelling offshore within UK waters. The OGUK Medical is also valid for those required to work in Holland, Denmark or Norway.

Appointments are available at our on-site medical suite while you are on-course (for a supplement) or as a standalone appointment.

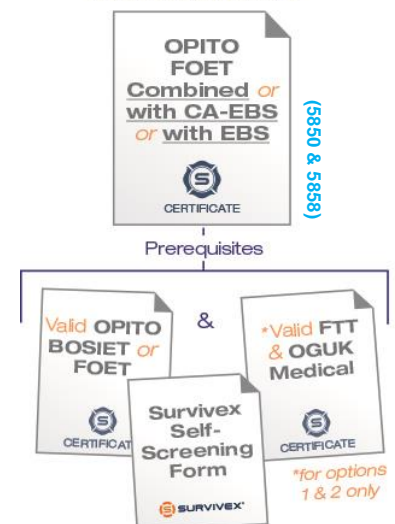
Anyone choosing a training option that includes CA-EBS, and who is not attending the Survivex Medical centre for their OGUK Medical, will be required to show a copy of their valid certificate prior to participating.

Prerequisites: None.

Add-on 2: Fit To Train (FTT) Assessment

Fit To Train Assessment (For In Water CA-EBS)

Included within duration of course (approx 15 mins if completed separately)

This is a prerequisite for anyone travelling offshore within UK waters.

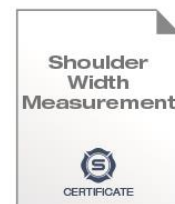
Appointments are available at our on-site medical suite while you are on-course (for a supplement) or as a standalone appointment.

Anyone choosing a training option that includes CA-EBS, and who is not attending the Survivex Medical centre for their FTT, will be required to show a copy of their valid certificate prior to participating.

Prerequisites: None.



AKA 'Shoulder Width'



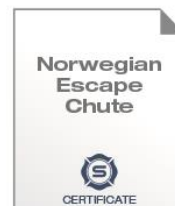
Add-on 3: Shoulder Width Measurement

Included within duration of course (approx 15 mins if completed separately)

This is a prerequisite for anyone travelling offshore within UK waters via helicopter.

Prerequisites: None.

AKA 'Escape Chute'

Add-on 4: Norwegian Escape Chute

Included within duration of course (approx 90 mins if completed separately)

This certification is a prerequisite for anyone required to work offshore within Norway. This module can be bolted onto any survival training option.

Prerequisites: Delegates will be required to complete our centre medical self-screening form prior to course commencement.

AKA 'MIST'



Prerequisites



Add-on 5: OPITO MIST (OPITO ref: 5301)

OPITO Minimum Industry Safety Training (MIST) (2 days)

This is required for all offshore workers in the UKCS.

Prerequisites: Delegates will be required to complete our centre medical self-screening form prior to course commencement.
